The Election Act of 2018

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT SENATE HERE ASSEMBLED:

SECTION I:

This is to state that the Chairman of the Student Court and the Chairman of the Student Senate shall be elected under the same process, same requirements, and by the Student Body of Hampden-Sydney College. Chairmen of both the Student Court and Student Senate shall be required to have at least one fully completed year of elected experience in their respective body before they are eligible to run for the position of chairman. The candidates for both Court Chairman and Senate Chairman must be a member of the rising senior class. (credit rankings as a senior, do not apply)
